

DURO-SHIELD[™] ACRYLIC BRUSH-GRADE MASTIC

DESCRIPTION:

Duro-Shield[™] Acrylic Brush-Grade Mastic is a heavy-bodied, flexible, elastomeric caulk and sealant for filling and patching cracks and voids on various substrates prior to application of the Duro-Shield Acrylic Roof Primer and Duro-Shield acrylic roof coatings.

Duro-Shield Acrylic Brush-Grade Mastic provides excellent adhesion, long life, and is resistant to failure by expansion, contraction or other joint movement.

ORDERING:

Approximate coverage rate is 25 square feet per gallon.

- 1-gallon pails (Item #4200)
- 5-gallon pails (Item #4250)

STORAGE AND HANDLING

- Protect product from freezing.
- Product must not be shipped in temperatures less than 40° F (5° C).
- Store product between 60° F (16° C) and 80° F (27° C), out of direct sunlight, for maximum shelf life. Shelf life is one year in an unopened container, from date of manufacture, when following these recommended storage procedures.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Read Safety Data Sheets (SDS) prior to using.
- Wear proper personal protective equipment, such as gloves and eye protection, per the SDS.
- Use only in well ventilated areas and avoid breathing vapors.
- Keep container closed when not in use.
- Do not expose closed containers to extreme heat.
- Keep away from children.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. General
 - Only apply product when ambient temperature is at least 50° F (10° C) and rising. Product must be stored between 60° F (15° C) and 80° F (26° C) for 24 hours prior to installation.
 - Do <u>not</u> apply when rain, cold or nightfall are imminent.
 - Do <u>not</u> use under water or below grade.
 - Thinning the product is **<u>not</u>** allowed.

2. Substrate Preparation

a. Repair, if necessary, the substrate by following *Substrate Preparation* instructions within the Duro-Shield Acrylic Roof Coating Installation Guide.

3. Cleaning Procedures

a. Apply to surfaces which are clean, dry and free of oil, mildew, grease or any other contaminants. Follow *Cleaning Procedures* within the Duro-Shield Acrylic Roof Coating Installation Guide.

4. Seam Treatment

- a. Joint dimensions should not exceed 1/4-inch by 1/2-inch deep. Use polyethylene backing rod for depths exceeding 1/2-inch.
- b. Use a putty knife or trowel to apply product to cracks and voids. Refillable caulking guns may also be used to apply the product.
- c. If re-coating is needed, wait 1 to 2 hours for first coat to dry.
- d. Allow to dry for 72 hours.

CLEANUP:

- Uncured product may be removed by wiping with warm water, soap and a clean cloth.
- Application equipment should be cleaned immediately after use with warm water, soap and a clean cloth.
